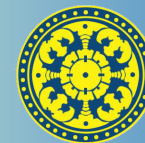
The text of the abstract is placed here. The abstract should be concise and should present the aim of the work, methods, essential results and conclusion. It should be typed in font size 11, single spacing should be used. Except for the first line, the text should be indented from the left margin by 10 mm. The length should not exceed 300 words.

THE TOTAL LENGTH OF THE SHORT ABSTRACT SHOULD NOT EXCEED 300 WORDS

The paper size of the abstract should be 21*29.5cm (A4) with a margin of 3cm on the top and bottom and 2.5cm on the right and left. The abstract should be submitted as a ".doc" file attachment.
