3. Registration Requirements:

- a. Complete the online registration by clicking "Register" and filling in personal information and an active email address on the website <u>https://utbk.unud.ac.id</u>. The registration flow and instructions can be found in the "Guide" menu on the site.
- b. Make the registration fee payment at the selected bank after choosing an exam session, by providing the Virtual Account number listed on the invoice generated by the system at https://utbk.unud.ac.id.
- c. Registration fee: IDR 2,400,000
- d. Indonesian citizens holding a diploma in a relevant field from an accredited Public or Private Higher Education Institution (domestic or abroad) recognized by the National Accreditation Board for Higher Education.
- e. Foreign citizens holding an equivalent diploma and a study permit issued by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology of the Republic of Indonesia, and who are proficient in proper Indonesian language to follow the Specialist Doctor Education Program (PPDS).
- f. Certified copies of diploma and academic transcripts.
- g. A softcopy of a passport-sized photo in *.jpg format, with a maximum resolution of $600 \ge 800$ pixels and file size not exceeding 300 KB.
- h. Complete Academic and Non-Academic Administrative Requirements can be downloaded directly from the online registration website <u>https://utbk.unud.ac.id</u> in the "required documents" menu after filling out personal data and selecting a study program.
- 4. General Health Test Requirements:
 - a. Free from active pulmonary tuberculosis.
 - b. Not color blind (partial or total).
 - c. Not a drug user.

A. Specialist Program in Reconstructive and Aesthetic Plastic Surgery

- 1. Valid certificates of ATLS and ACLS training and completion.
- 2. Certificate of Basic Surgical Skill (BSS) for general practitioners and/or Basic Skill Plastic Surgery (BSPS).
- 3. Statement letter declaring never been dismissed from another specialist medical education program.
- 4. Statement letter declaring never applied more than twice to the Plastic Surgery Specialist Program across Indonesia.
- 5. Scientific article or Letter of Acceptance (LOA), published in an accredited national journal after completing general medical education.
- 6. Letter of clinical work experience as a general practitioner in a hospital or community health center for at least one year (excluding internship)
- 7. Minimum GPA of 3.00.
- 8. Minimum TOEFL score of 500.
- 9. Female applicants must not be pregnant at the time of application
- 10. No ongoing legal issues
- 11. Maximum age at time of registration: 35 years
- 12. No color blindness, either partial or total

B. Specialist Program in Clinical Microbiology

- 1. Maximum age 45 years for both regular and institutional-sponsored applicants.
- 2. No color blindness (partial or total).
- 3. May only apply up to three times to the Clinical Microbiology Specialist Program at Udayana University.
- 4. No ongoing legal issues.
- 5. Minimum TOEFL score of 500.
- 6. Recommendation letter from the local Indonesian Medical Association (IDI), stating no ethical or malpractice violations.
- 7. Recommendation letter from a Clinical Microbiology Specialist at the applicant's hospital, or, if not available, from the nearest hospital or from the head of hospital/health institution.

C. Specialist Program in Radiology

I. Academic Requirements:

- 1. General practitioner medical degree.
- 2. Maximum age 35 years at time of application. Applicants over 35 and up to 40 may be considered if:
 - a. They are urgently needed in their region
 - b. They pass the basic competency and interview tests
 - c. They receive approval from at least 75% of examiners
- 3. Minimum GPA of 2.75 for both academic and professional education
- 4. Applicants who have failed the same program three times are not eligible to reapply.

II. Administrative Requirements:

- 1. Certified copy of original diploma.
- 2. Certified copy of academic transcript
- 3. Valid medical registration certificate (STR).
- 4. Curriculum vitae with recent passport photo.
- 5. Study permit letter from employer (for public/private employees).
- 6. Institutional letter stating commitment to release the candidate to study at Udayana University.
- 7. Employer's approval letter to pursue specialist education.
- 8. Recommendation letter from local IDI (no ethical/malpractice issues).

- 9. Recommendation from a Radiology Specialist at the applicant's hospital, or nearest available.
- 10. Police clearance certificate (SKCK).
- 11. Certificates of additional education/workshops/seminars, awards, or publications (if any).
- 12. Recent colored photo (600 x 800 pixels resolution).

III. Additional Requirements:

- 1. Free from active pulmonary TB, serious organ diseases, or mental disorders.
- 2. Not a drug user.
- 3. No color blindness (partial or total).

D. Specialist Program in Internal Medicine

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years for regular, 40 years for non-regular applicants (with official recommendation from institutions such as the military, police, or remote local governments).
- 2. Cannot have failed more than three times in applying to the Internal Medicine Specialist Program at Udayana University.
- 3. Female applicants must not be pregnant and must sign a declaration to remain not pregnant for the first two semesters.
- 4. Free from chronic infectious diseases and other chronic illnesses that may worsen during education

E. Specialist Program in Orthopaedics and Traumatology

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years
- 2. Physically and mentally healthy; not color blind
- 3. Must have completed the ATLS course
- 4. No legal issues
- 5. TOEFL score > 500
- 6. Actively involved in orthopaedic scientific activities/seminars
- 7. May only apply a maximum of 2 times to Orthopaedic and Traumatology Education Centers across Indonesia
- 8. Mandatory registration with the Orthopaedic Collegium Must have published scientific writing (e.g., journal articles, newspaper articles, or participation in scientific events)

F. Specialist Program in Pulmonology and Respiratory Medicine

- 1. Maximum age at registration: 35 years (attach colored photocopy of ID card)
- 2. Not color blind
- 3. Not a drug user
- 4. Female candidates must submit a statement declaring not pregnant during the selection process and agree not to take leave in the first year of education (stamped IDR 10,000). Applies to all candidates (male/female).
- 5. Parental/spousal permission letter (stamped IDR 10,000) to join the program and undergo education in the Pulmonology Specialist Program at FK Unud
- 6. No legal issues (attach SKCK police certificate)
- 7. May only apply a maximum of 3 times to this program at FK Unud

G. Specialist Program in Cardiology and Vascular Medicine

- 1. Age criteria for applicants:
 - General Practitioner: under 35 years
 - Military/Police/BUMN Doctor: under 40 years
 - Internal Medicine Specialist: under 45 years
- 3. GPA > 3.10
- 4. TOEFL score > 525
- 5. Must possess valid certificates for Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) and Electrocardiography (ECG) Training from PERKI

- 6. Letter from local IDI confirming no record of malpractice or ethical violations
- 7. Good Conduct Certificate (SKKB/SKCK) issued by the local police.
- 8. May apply a maximum of 3 times
- 9. Recommendation letter from the local branch of the Indonesian Society of Cardiovascular Specialists (PERKI) to join the program.

H. Specialist Program in Clinical Pathology

- 1. Maximum age
 - 35 years for regular program
 - 40 years for non-regular applicants (with recommendation from sending institutions such as military, police, local government, or remote areas)
- 2. Not color blind (partial or total)
- 3. May only apply a maximum of 3 times to the Clinical Pathology Specialist Program at Udayana University
- 4. Not pregnant at the time of registration
- 5. No legal issues
- 6. Minimum TOEFL score: 500

I. Specialist Program in Pediatrics

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years at the time of entry for the regular program
- 2. Applicants may not take the entrance exam more than 3 times for this program
- 3. Female applicants must not be pregnant and must sign a declaration agreeing not to become pregnant during the first year (2 initial semesters) of study
- 4. Minimum TOEFL score: 500
- 5. GPA ≥ 3.00

J. Specialist Program in Obstetrics and Gynecology

- 1. Applicants from both civil servant (PNS) and non-civil servant categories must not be over 35 years old, except for military, police, or teaching staff officially assigned by higher education institutions (public or private).
- 2. Applicants may only apply a maximum of 3 times at a single education center.
- 3. Female applicants must not be pregnant at the time of application or during the first year of study.

K. Specialist Program in Psychiatry

- 1. Maximum age
 - 35 years for regular program
 - 40 years for non-regular applicants (with recommendation from sending institutions such as military, police, local government, or remote areas)
- 2. Minimum GPA: 3.00
- 3. Applicants may take the entrance exam a maximum of 3 times in the Psychiatry Specialist Program at FK Udayana
- 4. The applicant's university must have at least a "B" accreditation
- 5. Female applicants must not be pregnant during the first semester of enrollment

L. Specialist Program in Ophthalmology

- 1. Maximum age at time of registration: 35 years (attach a color copy of national ID card)
- 2. Female applicants must attach a statement declaring not pregnant during the selection process and agree not to take leave in the first year of study (for both male and female candidates), with a stamp duty (IDR 10,000).
- 3. May only take the entrance exam a maximum of 3 times in the Ophthalmology Specialist Program at FK Udayana (Include a statement (with stamp duty) confirming not to exceed 3 applications to the program)

- 4. Must have good binocular vision (60 sec of arc) attach results of binocular vision test
- 5. Parental or spousal permission letter (with stamp duty) to participate in the selection and undergo study in the Ophthalmology Specialist Program at FK Udayana
- 6. No legal issues (attach SKCK)
- 7. Must possess an ATLS certificate (attach copy)

M. Specialist Program in Surgery

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years
- 2. Must have completed Basic Surgical Skill (BSS) for general practitioners
- 3. Must have completed ATLS training
- 4. Physically and mentally healthy; not color blind
- 5. TOEFL score > 500
- 6. Must have surgical work experience or have assisted in surgeries, supported by a recommendation letter from a surgery specialist (at least 1 recommendation)
- 7. Must have published scientific writing, either in journals, newspapers, or national surgical scientific events
- 8. Must be actively involved in surgical scientific seminars/conferences.

N. Specialist Program in Otorhinolaryngology – Head and Neck Surgery

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years for regular applicants and those sponsored by institutions
- 2. Must have attended at least 2 courses/symposiums in ENT-HNS within the last 3 years
- 3. May take the entrance test a maximum of 3 times at Udayana University
- 4. Female applicants must not be pregnant at the time of application
- 5. No legal issues
- 6. TOEFL score: minimum 500

O. Specialist Program in Dermatology and Venereology

- 1. Maximum age at registration: 35 years
- 2. May take the PPDS selection test in Dermatology and Venereology at FK Udayana a maximum of 3 times
- 3. Work experience as a general practitioner (not including internship), with a valid General Practitioner Registration Certificate (STR) for at least 1 year from date of issuance
- 4. Must hold valid and current ATLS and ACLS certificates
- 5. Must not be participating in the PPDS selection process at another institution during the same period

P. Specialist Program in Anatomical Pathology

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years
- 2. No color blindness (total or partial)
- 3. May apply a maximum of 3 times to Anatomical Pathology Specialist Programs across Indonesia, including at Udayana
- 4. Female applicants must not be pregnant at the time of registration and during the first semester of study

Q. Specialist Program in Neurosurgery

- 1. Maximum age at registration: 35 years; for military/police/civil servants: up to 40 years
- 2. May only apply a maximum of 2 times to the Neurosurgery Specialist Program at FK Udayana

- 3. Female applicants must not be pregnant at the time of registration
- 4. No legal issues
- 5. Minimum TOEFL score: 550
- 6. GPA ≥ 3.5

R. Specialist Program in Neurology

- 1. Maximum age: 35 years for both regular applicants and those sponsored by institutions
- 2. Minimum GPA:
 - Bachelor's in Medicine: 2.50
 - Medical Profession: 2.75
- 3. Minimum TOEFL score: 500
- 4. Must pass psychological evaluation
- 5. May only apply a maximum of 3 times at Udayana University
- 6. Must not be applying to another specialist program simultaneously
- 7. Female applicants must not be pregnant at the time of registration
- 8. No legal issues

S. Specialist Program in Anesthesiology and Intensive Therapy

- 1. Maximum age:
 - 35 years for regular applicants
 - 40 years for non-regular applicants (with special recommendation from sponsoring institutions such as TNI, Police, local government, or remote areas)
- 2. Valid ATLS and ACLS certificates
- 3. At least 3 symposium/workshop/seminar certificates related to Anesthesiology, preferably including BUAS (Bali Update Anesthesia Skill)
- 4. Publication in a national/international journal or scientific poster presentation in a relevant anesthesiology event
- 5. Female applicants must not be pregnant during the selection process

T. Specialist Program in Thoracic, Cardiac, and Vascular Surgery (TCVS) I. General Requirements:

- a. Curriculum Vitae;
- b. National ID Card (KTP);
- c. Valid Medical Registration Certificate (STR);
- d. Certified copies of medical degree and transcript;
- e. Active health insurance (BPJS Kesehatan and BPJS Employment;
- f. One 4x6 cm color photo with red background;
- g. Drug-free certificate;
- h. Police Clearance Certificate (SKCK).

II. Specific Requirements:

- a. UKDI (Indonesia Medical Competency Exam) passing certificate;
- b. GPA > 2.75;
- c. Eye health test result stating no color blindness;
- d. Minimum TOEFL score: 500;
- e. Valid ATLS, ACLS, and BSS training certificates;
- f. Certificates from scientific activities in the field of TCVS;
- g. Recommendation letter from sponsoring institution/local government that guarantees a return-to-work placement;
- h. Clinical experience (preferably meeting stated conditions), proven by a copy of SIP or clinical experience during internship;
- i. Internship completion letter;
- j. Certificate from a government-authorized hospital stating the applicant has no physical or genetic defects;

- k. Maximum age: 35 years at the start of the specialist program;
- 1. Statement of willingness to be assigned anywhere in Indonesia after graduation

U. Specialist Program in Clinical Nutrition

- I. General Requirements:
 - 1. Maximum age: 35 years; for civil servants/contract doctors/military/police/Tubel recipients: up to 40 years (with proof of status);
 - 2. Minimum TOEFL score: 450 (from LIA or a recognized public university language center);
 - 3. Female applicants must not be pregnant during the selection process;
 - 4. No color blindness (total or partial);
 - 5. No legal issues;
 - 6. Minimum GPA: 2.75 for both academic and professional degrees.

II. Specific Requirements:

- 1. Body Mass Index (BMI) between 20–25 kg/m²
- 2. Certificate of completion for TNT, LLL, or other clinical nutrition training
- 3. Institutional-sponsored applicants must attach a return-to-service declaration
- 4. Tax Identification Number (NPWP)
- 5. BPJS Health participant card
- 6. Medical Competency Certificate from the Indonesian Medical Collegium
- 7. Valid Good Clinical Practice (GCP) certificate
- 8. Copy of a certificate for participation in a national poster competition organized by PDGKI (minimum 1)
- 9. Copy of a certificate for participation in a scientific event organized by PDGKI (minimum 1)
- 10. Proof of hospital work/internship for at least 6 months (official letter from hospital management)
- 11. At least one scientific publication related to nutrition, published in a national or international journal
- 12. Graduate from a university with Accreditation A

V. Subspecialist Program in Internal Medicine

- 1. Must hold a Specialist in Internal Medicine degree from an accredited program with a minimum rating of "Very Good" (Baik Sekali);
- 2. Basic Endoscopy Training Certificate (for the Gastroenterology-Hepatology subspecialty);
- 3. Basic Ultrasonography Certificate (for the Gastroenterology-Hepatology subspecialty)
- 4. Recommendation letter from the Collegium of Internal Medicine;
- 5. Certified copy of the Specialist in Internal Medicine diploma;
- 6. Certified copy of the academic transcript for the Specialist in Internal Medicine program;
- 7. Copy of valid Medical Registration Certificate (STR) as a Specialist in Internal Medicine;
- 8. Practice license (SIP) as a specialist physician for at least 6 months;
- 9. Medical certificate from a government hospital stating the applicant is in good health and not color blind;
- 10. Reassignment letter after program completion (for applicants currently employed by a government hospital);

- 11. Study assignment letter from the sponsoring institution including the reason for assignment; and
- 12. Study permit letter from the applicant's immediate supervisor at the workplace.

W. Subspecialist Program in Obstetrics and Gynecology

- 1. Recommendation letter from the sponsoring institution or local government
- 2. Two recommendation letters from members of the related subspecialty association
- 3. Study assignment letter from the sponsoring institution including the reason for assignment
- 4. Certified copy of the Specialist in Obstetrics and Gynecology (Sp.OG) diploma, signed by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at the originating university
- 5. Certified academic transcript signed by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at the originating university
- 6. Copy of valid Medical Registration Certificate (STR) as a Specialist in Obstetrics and Gynecology
- 7. Practice license (SIP) as a specialist physician for at least 1 year
- 8. Maximum age at the start of the program: 45 years
- 9. Recommendation letter from the Indonesian Collegium of Obstetrics and Gynecology
